HEATSEEKERS CHART AT #23 AND FOLK CHART AT #19  
ITS FIRST WEEK OUT**

**Long's U.S./European/UK Tour Continues into November**

British singer-songwriter Bobby Long is celebrating the release of his new album, **ODE TO THINKING**, by taking it on the road in the United States, Europe and his native United Kingdom. The album, which was released worldwide on August 7 from Compass Records, has made its way onto the Billboard Heatseekers chart this week, landing at #23, and on the Billboard Folk chart at #19, its first week following release. Powered by the first single, "I'm Not Going Out Tonight, which is picking up steam at AAA radio, **ODE TO THINKING** has been enjoying comments ranging from "Long is a marvelously evocative singer whose rich, husky vocal tone enunciates the clarity of the stories," (*Music Connection*) to *PopMatters* referring to the album as "elegant in its acoustic simplicity" while *Making a Scene* said "This album really is an 'ode to thinking.'

Now residing in New York, Long, who is best known for his powerfully evocative lyrics set to haunting melodies, has been hard at work bringing his new music to live audiences since launching the tour on August 1 at McCabe's Guitar Shop in Los Angeles. He appeared worldwide on Voice of America's

"Border Crossings" broadcast on the day of release and on the Woodsongs Old Time Radio Hour, which streamed live this week from the Lyric Theatre in Lexington, KY and will be broadcast on hundreds of radio and television outlets in the fall. There are

also recent live sessions posted from last.fm, relix.com, ourvinyl.tv and daytrotter.com as well as frequent local radio and television appearances, all showcasing the poignant material that embodies **ODE TO THINKING**.

The album was recorded in Austin, Texas with producer Mark Hallman at his Congress House Studios. It was made possible by a fan-fueled crowdfunding campaign on PledgeMusic.com that closed last week following the fulfillment of pre-orders for the new CD.

Bobby Long emerged from London's burgeoning folk music renaissance, cultivating a strong fan base for his music. He has previously released two well received albums, *A WINTER TALE* (2011) and *WISHBONE* (2013) as well as a five-song EP called *THE BACKING SINGER* (2011) and a volume of poetry, *LOSING MY BROTHERHOOD* (2012). He is planning a follow-up poetry book for next year.

His U.S. shows continue through September 27 after which he spends the month of October touring Europe, culminating in a week of shows in the UK in November. He graced the Acoustic Stage of the venerable Glastonbury Festival in England in June for the first time, his first high profile appearance in his native country.
